



Words from Jay Lynn Gomez:

"My cardboard work comes from a deep place within me. Experiencing the loss of my grandmother will forever be the formative moment. There's something about the ephemerality of the discarded material that I gravitate towards and find it therapeutic to transform it into art.

When I was asked by Charlie James Gallery to create work for the Frieze Art Fair, I knew I wanted to collaborate with Patrick Martinez again. We talked about our loved ones and their lasting influence on us, and I immediately connected with him sharing about his Mother. Patrick's Mom. Evelyn Martinez, cleaned the Federal building in downtown Los Angeles for many years. She cleaned it with pride, when she was sick and when her body was failing her. I felt honored that Patrick shared with me beautiful, personal photos which inspired me to create a portrait representing a memory of her. He explained to me how he often paints in the same movements she did while cleaning, so I knew where I wanted to place my figure."




